



School/CBHSVA Code of Conduct/Eligibility

CBHSVA follows the Colorado High School Activities Association code of conduct/eligibility.

All athletes must carry a minimum of 5 academic classes and be a full time student at a Colorado State High School. Special cases involving out of state students and/or schools, and students who attend more than one eligible high school should be referred to the CBHSVA Board of Directors for status determination.

The student-athlete must receive a passing grade in a minimum of 5 classes (or have a minimum of 25 passing credits) to be eligible for athletic competition.

Summer school credits accepted by the school may be used to replace credits in subjects failed during previous semesters. Before taking summer school courses, check with your athletic director for specifics.

Make-up work shall not be permitted after the close of the grading period for the purpose of becoming eligible. Special cases involving special circumstances should be referred to your athletic director or building principal.

The school and/or team may elect to impose stricter academic standards and guidelines with the approval of the building athletic director. These standards may limit the participation of the student-athlete in events, contests, or performances.

Upon request your school principal or coach will verify that you meet the school and team standards of safety, citizenship, conduct and sportsmanship.

If you are ejected from a game for unsportsman like conduct, you will be ineligible for the next game. Repeated unsportsman like conduct will result in a school/CBHSVA review of student's future eligibility.

Participants must maintain athletic insurance for the entire pre, regular, and post season.
